### FIA FORMULA TWO CHAMPIONSHIP TESTING GETS UNDERWAY AT SILVERSTONE

Having carried out a rigorous test programme over 2010 and 2011 in which one set of FrenoCarbon H-Carb discs completed 6000 kilometres without any incident and using only two sets of brake pads, Formula Two Ltd. decided to specify FrenoCarbon H-Carb discs and pads for the FIA Formula Two Championship in 2012.

Despite a tight manufacturing and delivery schedule all the H-Carb discs and pads were delivered well before the first test at Silverstone on the 28<sup>th</sup> March 2010.

At the 28<sup>th</sup> March 2012 test all the H-Carb discs performed faultlessly and their performance contributed to a 2 second improvement in lap time over last year's car. The drivers gave the brakes a huge vote of confidence with one driver, who had driven in last year's car, remarking that "The first three laps I thought I was in a different car".

FrenoCarbon Ltd. will be providing technical support and backup at the first two rounds of the FIA Formula 2 Championship at Silverstone on 13-15<sup>th</sup> April 2012.
